

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C205 Mill Green from its junction with C205 Hall Road for a distance of 351 metres southwards in the PARISH OF BURSTON & SHIMPLING because of the installation of a new foul sewer.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 16<sup>th</sup> January 2018 to 14<sup>th</sup> February 2018 for the duration of the works, expected to be 22 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: C205 Hall Road, U76235 Back Lane, C472 Diss Road, C205 Mill Road (Burstons and Shimpling/ Heywood).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

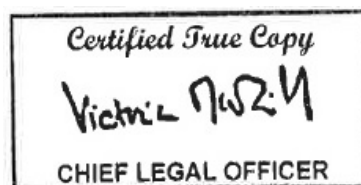
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
