

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the U76107 Long Lane from its junction with C205 Hall Road for a distance of 65 metres northwards in the PARISH OF BURSTON AND SHIMPLING because of installation of a new foul sewer.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 20th April 2018 to 5th May 2018 for the duration of the works, expected to be 11 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: U76107 Long Lane/ Chequers Lane/ Upper Street, C348 New Road/ Lower Street, C342 Burston Road/ Gissing Road, U76108 Bridge Road (Gissing/ Burston and Shimpling).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
